- B. Enemies all around. Psalm 25:1-3
- C. He had sinned. Psalm 51:1-2
- D. He had troubles. Psalm 86:1-7

II. OUR STRUGGLES

- A. Trials. I Peter 4:12; 2 Corinthians 12:7-9
- B. Temptations. James 1:13-15; I Corinthians 10:13
- C. Sin. Romans 3:21-23; 7:21-25

III. WE NEED HIM EVERY HOUR

- A. So we draw near. James 4:7-8
 - 1. In humility. I Peter 5:6-7
- B. We mourn for our sins. James 4:9-10
- C. And we pray. Acts 8:21-22; I Peter 3:12

CONCLUSION:

- A. David struggled with enemies and trials as well as his own personal troubles with temptation and sin.
- B. We have similar struggles, but God is faithful to all who will draw near to Him.
