- A. He is the "man upstairs." Numbers 23:19
- B. That God doesn't know. Psalm 73:11-14
- C. That we can hide from God. Psalm 139:7-12
- D. We can serve God our way. Isaiah 55:8-9
- E. That sin is no big deal. Romans 6:20-23

## III. WHAT GOD WANTS

- A. Fear Him and obey. Ecclesiastes 12:13-14
- B. Trust Him with all your heart. Proverbs 3:5-6
- C. Deny yourself. Luke 9:23-26
- D. Draw near to Him. James 4:7-8
