- B. Or poverty. Proverbs 30:8-9

II. JUST ENOUGH!

- A. The food allotted to me. Proverbs 30:8
- B. Life is more than things. Luke 12:13-15
- C. God requires work. I Thessalonians 4:11-12
 - 1. Even to help others. Ephesians 4:28
- D. God will provide. Matthew 6:31-34

III. CONTENTMENT

- A. Gladness in the heart. Psalm 4:7-8
- B. I have learned contentment. Philippians 4:11-13
- C. Godliness with contentment. I Timothy 6:6-8
- D. In trusting God. Hebrews 13:5-6
 - 1. But not trusting riches. I Timothy 6:17

CONCLUSION:

- A. "I wish you enough" is a good wish. Not too much riches that you will forget God, or too much poverty that you will steal.
- B. Instead God requires that we work with our hands, and promises that He will provide.
- C. In trusting Him we learn to be content while we wait for life!
