- B. But this passage does not glorify the messenger. It shows the importance of the message.
- C. Unless it's an apostle, the messenger has no authority but may only speak the message of God.

I. IT'S NOT THE MESSENGER

- A. Earthen vessels. 2 Corinthians 4:5-7
- B. Not charisma or human wisdom. I Corinthians 2:1-5
- C. It's not about men. I Corinthians 1:11-17

II. IT'S ABOUT THE MESSAGE

- A. Christ crucified. I Corinthians 2:1-2
 - 1. Death, burial & resurrection. I Cor. 15:3-4
- B. To some, foolishness. I Corinthians 1:18-31
- C. God's power to save. Romans 1:16

III. NO OTHER GOSPEL

- A. No other gospel. Galatians 1:6-9
- B. Did not come from men. Galatians 1:11-12
- C. Must obey it. Romans 10:13-17
- D. Believe and be baptized. Mark 16:15-16

CONCLUSION:

- A. It's not about which preacher said it or his charisma or lack of it; it's about what God said and His message regarding salvation.
- B. The power to save is in the gospel, and though men count it foolishness, it saves those who believe and obey.
