  - 1. Jesus. John 19:31-34
- B. A fountain will be opened. Zechariah 13:1
- C. The idols will be cut off. Zechariah 13:2
- D. They will strike the shepherd. Zechariah 13:7
  - 1. Again, Jesus. Matthew 26:31

## II. A FOUNTAIN OF BLOOD

- A. Not animal blood. Hebrews 10:1-4
- B. Jesus' own blood. Hebrews 9:12-14
- C. His blood redeems from sin. I Peter 1:18-19
- D. His blood washes. Revelation 1:5; Acts 22:16
- E. His blood cleanses. I John 1:7
- F. His blood reconciles. Colossians 1:19-21

## III. OBLIGATIONS

- A. Be a living sacrifice. Romans 12:1-2
- B. Live for Him. 2 Corinthians 5:14-15
- C. Serve & follow Him daily. Luke 9:23
