- B. Aimless (vain) conduct. I Peter 1:18-19
 - 1. Ignorance of God's plan. Romans 10:1-4
- C. Lawless deeds. Titus 2:11-14
- D. And of the law. Galatians 4:4-7

III. THE PRICE OF REDEMPTION

- A. Jesus' blood. I Peter 1:18-19
- B. To bring redemption. Hebrews 9:11-15
- C. While we were still sinners. Romans 5:6-8
- D. Bought at a price. I Corinthians 6:19-20
